We appreciate your prayers for us in this previous year, they were sincerely felt, and genuinely needed. Our church and its ministries have continued to grow, with us having hit a new high attendance of over sixty people; and more people coming to trust Christ as Savior. We will actually this week teaching soul winning classes at our church, so that others might start joining us.

I mentioned a building in my last letter, I have spoken with the owner; and seen the property. It is perfect for our needs and in a great location. The building is large enough for our church, for the foreseeable future, and has an apartment attached for our family. The price is very good for this part of the city, but still considerably out of our price range; it is nearly half the price of any building its size. Please pray for us though, we desperately need God's guidance in whether this property is His will or not.
